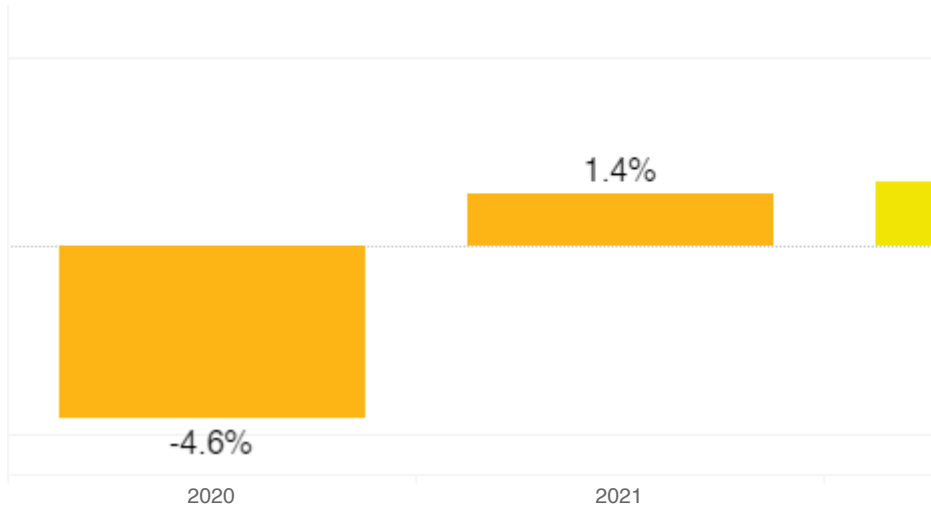

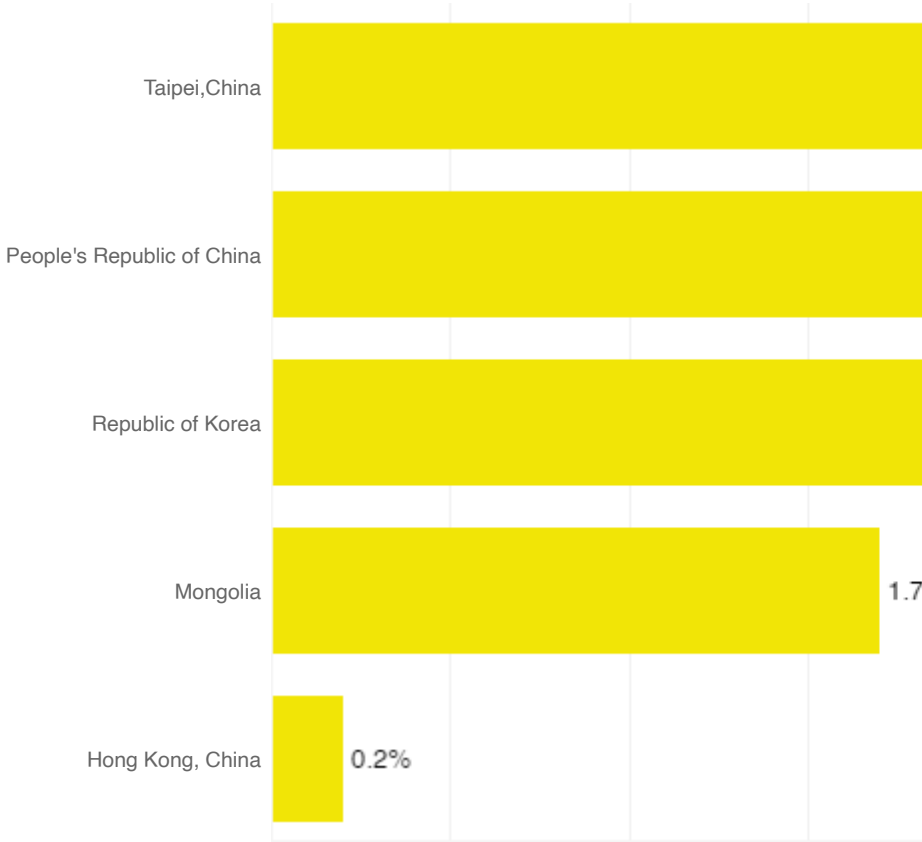

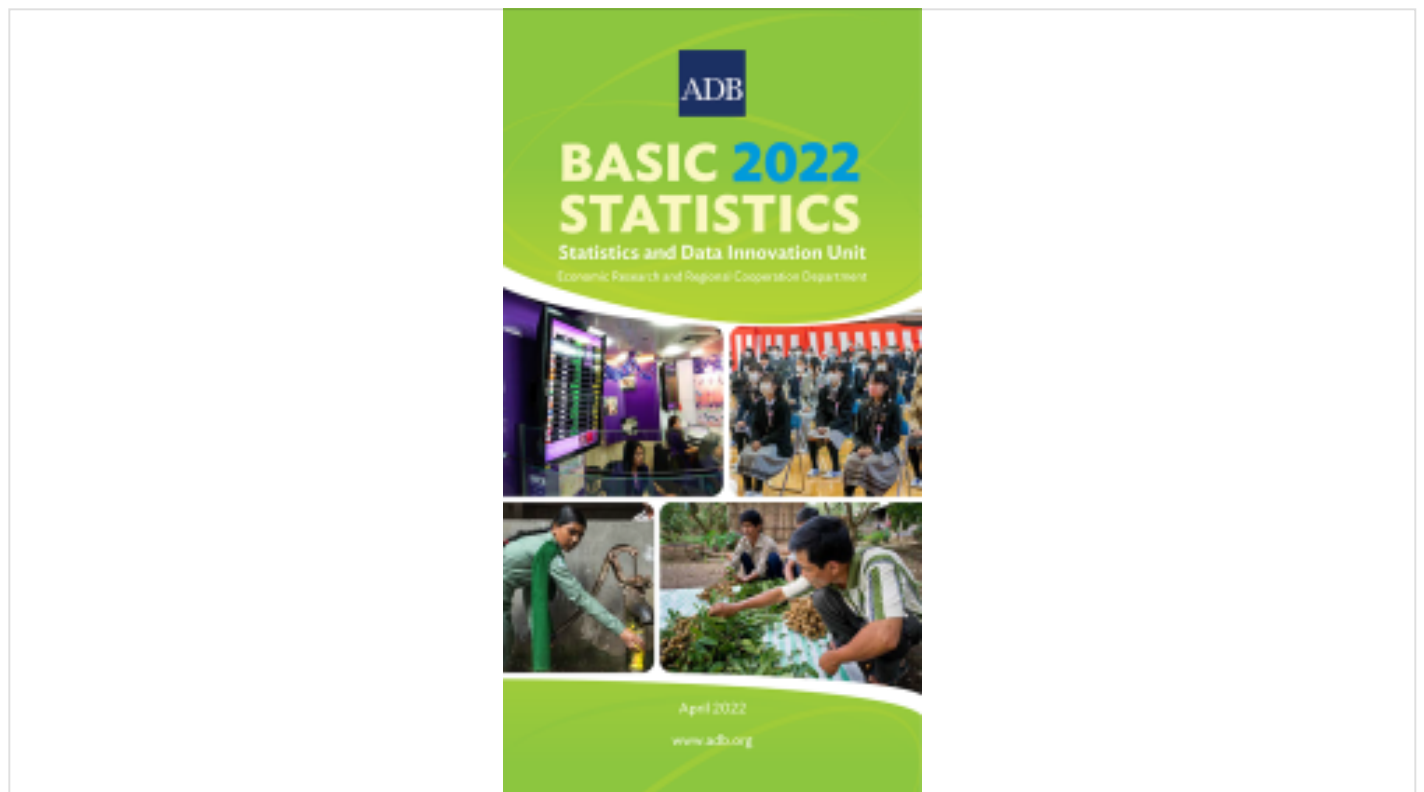


Key Indicators
